

## Response to the Adults Health and Wellbeing Partnership Draft Delivery Plan, August 2009

- Great to see all this information pulled together in one place – this is very helpful indeed for understanding the delivery of the partnership and we are sure it has taken quite some doing to get into one document!
- The case study (on page 13 of the version we saw) is really helpful in making explicit the links between the Board and the Health and Wellbeing Network.
- Within the delivery plan - annexe A, it would be useful to cross - reference to other strategic documents to show connections where it is possible to do so.
- More information about how monitoring and accountabilities work in practice. What accountability does the partnership have and how does this work across the whole delivery plan?
- What are the principles that guide partnership across sectors and services that are supported by the Board?
- More on links with strategic commissioning and how this supports the delivery plan.
- There is a big emphasis current activity in the plan – would be useful to see more about future direction of services, a route map for the next few years. It would also be helpful to have more information on timescales for delivery.
- Much more detail is needed on priorities around safeguarding vulnerable adults, particularly some clearly identified resources for this important issue.
- Information and references on community engagement – defining the approach the Partnership takes to engagement and how this is resourced? Engagement should be a cross-cutting theme which underpins the concept of the plan. This should be a priority for development – at present there are only scattered references such as resources for communication with BME communities identified under the cancer prevention theme.
- More about how funding is allocated across the delivery plan – transparency on this would be welcome.
- What are the contingency plans for the (inevitable) budget cuts that will come in next year?
- What are the administrative costs in delivering the partnership structures and how are these to be resourced in the future? This is an issue for all partners.
